Requirements Change Notice
Decreased Monitoring for LEAD AND COPPER

Dear JAMES WADE:

According to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment ("Department") records, PARK CENTER WD ("Supplier") is currently required to collect 40 LEAD AND COPPER sample(s) every 6 Months at Facility ID DS001 - Sample Point ID Distribution System.

The Supplier is now required to collect 20 sample(s) for LEAD AND COPPER every Year between June and September starting January 01, 2019 per Section 11.26(2)(d) of the Colorado Primary Drinking Water Regulations ("Regulation 11"), 5 CCR 1002-11.

The Supplier's monitoring schedule, posted at <a href="wqcdcompliance.com/schedules">wqcdcompliance.com/schedules</a>, contains detailed monitoring requirements and has been updated to reflect the changes. Please begin collecting drinking water samples in accordance with the schedule, discard any outdated schedules, and regularly check the website as schedules are updated on a weekly basis.
